- Register for Payment Set Up for one-time or recurring payments from your checking or savings account.

Pay by Bank Account

(no fees)

• Pay online to make an tax payment from your checking or savings account without a fee.

• Use the Electronic Federal Tax System (EFTPS) to make one-time or recurring payments from your checking or savings account.

• If you e-file with tax software or a tax professional, you can schedule an automatic funds withdrawal (EFW).

Pay by Card

(processing fees apply)

- Pay online or by phone.
- When e-filing pay through tax preparation software.
- Processing fees go to a payment processor and limits apply. The IRS does not receive any fees.

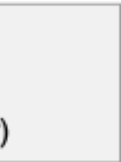
